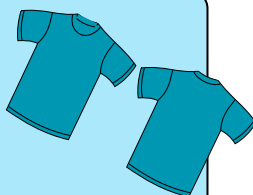
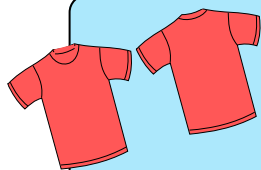

## SPOTLIGHT

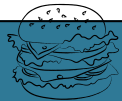
