This month we'd like to shine our spotlight on Mr. Ed, who has been greeting us with a JRW Custodial smile since 1989!

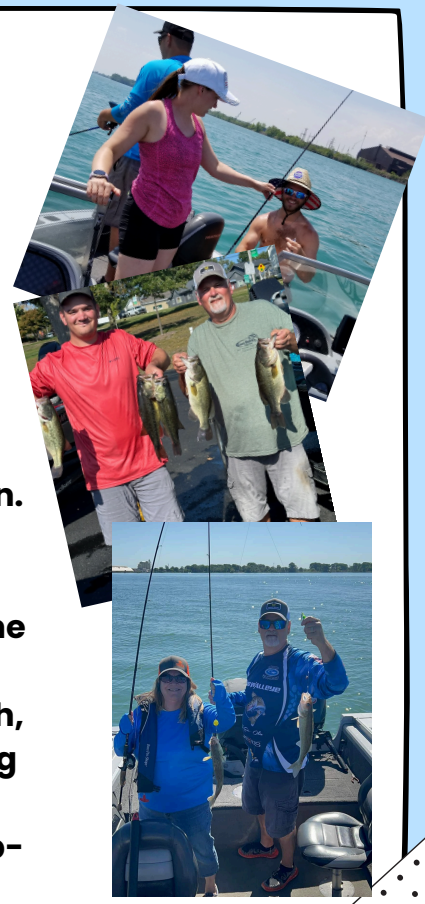
